
WORKSHOP ON PEDAGOGY FOR EFFECTIVE USE OF ICT IN ENGINEERING EDUCATION

iTEP (THE INTERNATIONAL TEST OF ENGLISH PROFICIENCY)

iTEP (The International Test of English Proficiency) Academic Plus Exam was organized for the 50 students of B.Tech. 7th semester on December 9, 2014 at Dronacharya College of Engineering, Gurgaon. The exam was conducted in two shifts.
