


Library is the heart, mind and soul of an educational institution and a fountain-head of innovativeness, inspiration and insight both for the students and the faculty. Learning and library are to each other as the light to the lamp.

Esthetically designed and State of the art Information Resource Centre (Library) is located on the 3rd floor of the College building and is totally air conditioned. It has been systematically and steadily strengthened. The IRC's operation and services are fully computerized with "e-Granthalaya" multi-user Integrated Library Automation Software, developed by National Informatics Centre, New Delhi and a Bar Code based circulation system is in use. The IRC is equipped with more than 38000 books from different streams. Besides these text and reference books IRC is also subscribing a large number of national and international journals, magazines and dailies. Bibliographic records of IRC's holdings can be, accessed through the e-Granthalaya's On Line Public Access Catalogue(OPAC). The IRC is also maintains a good collection of important educational CDs on Engineering & Technology. The college is an institutional member of British Council Division Library, New Delhi and American Information Resource Centre, New Delhi. Our students can avail Library and Information Services of these centers for their specialized information needs, where in they can get a very large volume of books & periodicals along with audio-video, digital and online information resources. The IRC also provides Book Bank facility wherein students can get the textbooks issued for the entire semester.

The National Programme on Technology Enhanced Learning (NPTEL), a project funded by the Ministry of Human Resource Development India (MHRD), provides e-learning through online Web and Video courses in Engineering, Sciences, Technology, Management and Humanities. The mission of NPTEL is to enhance the quality of Engineering education in the country by providing **free online courseware.** The main objective of NPTEL program is to enhance the quality of engineering education in the country by developing curriculum based video and web courses. This is being carried out by IITs (Seven), IISc Bangalore and other premier institutions as a collaborative project.

These course materials adhering to the syllabi of All India Council for Technical Education and the slightly modified curricula of major affiliating Universities. It has developed curriculum based video courses and web-based e-courses targeting students and faculty of institutions offering UG engineering programs.

Now there is no need to download these courses from the Internet, they are available throughout the campus via college LAN/ Wi-Fi on dedicated NPTEL Server in the Library

Our faculty members and students are advised to make use of these video and web courses for their teaching and study.

- N-LIST (National Library and Information Services infrastructure for Scholarly Content) is an ambitious programme of INFLIBNET / UGC-INFONET. Under section 2 (f) and 12 (B) of UGC Act 1956, our college is the member of this UGC funded programme.
- The N-LIST programme provides access to more than 6000+ e-journals (with back files for 10 years) and 97,000+ e-books.
- Individual Login ID and password for all our faculty members as well as for all the students have been provided for accessing the resource by INFLIBNET. All those who have not collected yet, are requested to collect it from the Library.

- This interface provides access to the <u>On Line Public Access Catalogue (OPAC)</u> of the Information Resource Centre (Library) of the college.
- On-line Public Access Catalogue (OPAC) allows searches by keywords, or through several access points like author, title, subject, publisher and year of publication. Current status of the document issued or available is also shown. The system is extremely user friendly and enables searches to be conducted with ease and speed. Database of library books is being updated on day-to-day basis with details of recently acquired books.

BOOK BANK FACILITY

□It is an optional facility.
□ Presently Book Bank Facility is open for First Year Students only.
□A Security money of Rs.2500/- will be required to be deposited, which will be refundable after the publication of first year result.
□A fee of Rs.500/- will be charged annually (For two semesters) at the commencement of session.
□A student may get a maximum of 6 books from the Book Bank at a time for entire semester.
□ Books will be issued at beginning of each semester as per the schedule notified for the purpose.
■ Members will be required to deposit the books after the completion of the exam as per the schedule notified.
■A fine will be levied if book will not be returned as per the schedule.
☐ Members will be responsible for any damage caused for the books. Members are advised to verify the physical condition of the books at time of its lending.
☐ If a book is lost, the member will be required to pay double of the current market price of the book or replace the copy plus Rs.100/-
□ Books will be issued on first come first served basis.

IRC is using "e-Granthalaya" multiuser Integrated IRC Automation Software, developed by National Informatics Centre, New Delhi, which has a inbuilt facility to support Bar code based circulation System. All books have been Bar Coded and all the members have been given bar coded membership cards. IRC is using a thermal bar code printer to generate bar codes labels
