


Live Projects Undertaken By Students:

WEB SPIDER

The objective was to build a customized multithreaded, focused crawler. This will crawl the web, based on the relevance of the web page, reducing thereby the crawl space and searching for the required page efficiently. The world-wide web, having over 350 million pages, continues to grow rapidly at an amazing pace of a million pages per day. About 600 GB of text changes every month. Such a tremendous growth and flux poses basic limits of scale for today's generic crawlers and search engines. In spite of using high-end multiprocessors and exquisitely crafted crawling software, the largest crawls cover only 30-40% of the web, and refreshes take weeks to a month. With such unprecedented scaling challenges for general-purpose crawlers and search engines, we propose a hypertext resource discovery system called a Focused Crawler.

The goal of a focused crawler is to selectively seek out pages that are relevant to a pre-defined set of topics. The topics are specified not using keywords, but using exemplary documents .





Software Used:

The feasibility of the developed software developed can be stated as under:

- The new application requires Net beans1 (advanced compiler of Java)
- JDBC- ODBC bridge to create a link between Java application and data stored

Hardware Used:

The present hardware setup of the organization may be sufficient for running the software applications to be developed. The hardware feasibility of the software developed is as under:

- Servers used to manage the application
- High bandwidth for faster parsing of data

Technology Focus :



EDGE TECHNOLOGY

EDGE stands for **Enhanced Data rates for GSM Evolution** (or IMT Single Carrier (IMT-SC)). EDGE is considered a 3G radio technology and is part of ITU's 3G definition. EDGE is the most talked about technology in mobile communication technologies in recent times and it turned out to be the evolution of most widely used GSM technology. EDGE technology facilitates better data transmission rates with improved spectrum efficiency and the best part of EDGE is capability of supporting new applications and improved mobile communication capabilities. EDGE can also be known as extended version of GPRS. Therefore it is also called EGPRS.

EDGE is a way to achieve better data rates on GSM networks. EGDE is add on to GPRS network and can not work alone. It works with the new modulation techniques and new channel coding that is used for both Packet switch and circuit switch voice and data networks. Today EDGE is supported by all major chip vendors for both GSM and WCDMA/HSPA.

EDGE technology can deliver three times faster bit rate ratio compared to GPRS in given time. This is how EDGE transmits at a better rate. GPRS can transfer data at the rates of 115 kbps theoretically and up to 160 kbps on physical layer, whereas EDGE/EGRPS can transfer up to 384 kbps on physical layer and 473.6 kbps theoretically. The Latest modulation and error tolerant transmission methodologies with help of mechanism of improved link adaption have made rates of EGPRS/EDGE possible. This has enabled improved spectrum efficiency and usability of modern applications like Wireless Internet, Emailing, File Transferring and video calling.
