

Be a part of the world's biggest science communication competition!

FameLab is an international training programme and competition designed to inspire, motivate and develop the capacity of young scientists and engineers to actively engage with the public and stakeholders. The competition targets young scientists, mathematicians and engineers to talk about an aspect of their science in 3 minutes only, without any power point but with any choice of props that they can carry on to stage.

In India, FameLab will train 120 shortlisted applicants across the country in science communication, before they compete at regional and national rounds. The national winners will visit the Cheltenham Science Festival in the UK in June 2017, and compete at the International FameLab Final which had participation from over 27 countries in 2016.

The eligibility criteria are listed below:

Anyone between the age of 20 and 40 years as of 1 June 2016, who is:

- A student of science, mathematics or engineering
- A scientist or researcher
- A lecturer in science, mathematics and engineering subjects
- Applying science, mathematics and engineering in Industry or Government
